Mathematics

In the English classroom this week we identified who the characters are in the stories, 'The Three Little Pigs', 'The Gingerbread Man' and 'Goldilocks and The Three Bears'. We then counted the number of characters in the stories. We compared the number of characters in the different stories and identified which story has more or less characters.

This week in the Chinese class we focused on the sequence of stories. We discussed the beginning, the middle and the end of the story. The children used the numbers 1,2,3 to learn the concept of sequencing. We are also practicing sequencing with different stories during group time.
