The children were very excited to take their boats to their Swimming Lesson this week and discover if their 'Float & Sink' predictions were correct. The children were very interested in the result and talked a lot about what happened to their boat. After the experiment we discussed as a whole group what happened and why the boats floated or sank. Thank you parents very much for helping your child make their boats. They engaged in scientific thought and an experiment with the boats. We had 33 clever thinking little scientists!!

English

This week we did a craft activity and focused on the letter 'A, a'. The children talked about what fruit they like and many children said they liked apples. We looked at the different coloured apples we can buy. We made an apple craft. The children chose what colour they wanted to make their apple, scrunched up crepe paper and stuck the crepe paper on their apple.

We will still continue to review all the letters/sounds everyday at school by singing the songs, looking at the Jolly Phonics big books, talking about letters we see in the environment and making some crafts related to various letters.
