UOI (Unit of Inquiry)

In the Chinese classroom we discussed the story 'The Gingerbread Man'. We questioned the children about the characters who are in the story, what happens at the beginning of the story, what happens at the end of the story, is this a happy ending or sad ending etc. We set aside a new corner for the mini puppet show in the Chinese classroom. Many of the children enjoyed using the puppets to retell this story with their peers.

In the English classroom we continued to learnt more about the parts of a story. We used sequence cards to identify what parts of a story are the beginning, middle and end. We also reviewed who the characters are in the different stories.
