UOI (Unit of Inquiry)

We focused on the 'School' unit in Chinese class this week. We discussed and found out that there are more people who work at school who help us. In the English classroom this week we focused on number '4'. The children read books related to numbers such as, '123 With Peppa Pig'. They used their bodies to count up to 4. During free play time in the morning the children had many opportunities to practice number recognition and trace numbers 1-20. During class time the children traced the number '4' page of their 'Number Tracing Book'.

But putting the numbers in the right order and sequence is more challenging for the children. They practiced and engaged in different number activities in the classroom.
