26th May 2017

This is the final week of the 'Water' Unit of Inquiry. The children continued to talk about boats which pirate boats in mind. We read lots of books about pirates and thought about the weight of treasure and what would happen to the boats if the treasure was heavy or light. We did an experiment with a pirate boat and some treasure (jelly) to see if the pirate boat would float or sink.

Next week we will return to the 'School' Unit. The focus will be on preparing for the End of Year Concert and finishing work for the portfolio.
