In the English classroom this week we reviewed counting and number recognition. We looked at the calendar everyday and played number recognition games such as, picking numbers from a Lucky Dip. For example, if you go shopping you can ask your child to find numbers and count fruit/vegetables in the supermarket.

We also talked about holidays we just had. Some children went to the sea, some went to the mountains and some took an airplane and had a trip with their family.
