Mathematics

In the English classroom this week we reviewed counting and number recognition. We looked at the calendar everyday and played number recognition games such as, throwing big dice, saying the number and then jumping on the corresponding number on the number mat. We also focused on number '3' and the children traced the number '3'. Please continue to encourage your child to count outloud and find numbers in the environment. For example, if you go shopping you can ask your child to find numbers and count fruit/vegetables in the supermarket.

As well as continuing to learn to count in rote 1-30, in the Chinese class we focused on recognition of the numbers 1-10. We did some one-on-one counting activities with each child in the morning. It helps reinforce number sense for all the children and informs us of what areas we need to work on with each individual child. We will
