This week we continued our "School" unit. In Chinese class the children continued to become more familiar with how to say 'PE, Library, English, Thai and Music' subjects in Chinese. In the English class the children continued to look at photos and discuss who their Teachers are and what they teach. English

This week we started learning the English alphabet through the Jolly Phonics program. The children enjoyed singing the "S" song, doing the action and writing the letter 'S'. Mathematics

This week the children continued to experiment with numbers by identifying numbers on cards and then placing the correct number of counters next to it to represent the number. The children also engaged in sorting activities. We sorted dinosaur counters by colour. The children enjoyed finding different colour dinosaurs as specified by the Teacher and placing them on the corresponding coloured plate.

In the Chinese classrooms the students are continuing to learn about shapes and colors. On a daily basis the children also engage in counting activities, e.g. counting the date, counting from 1-20, the number of friends in the class, the number of boys and girls present etc.
